




Ten Kids Enrolled in School Kabul Orphan Care




The Street Kids Initiative enrolled ten orphaned children, ages seven to fifteen into school. They now have room and board and will receive a formal education under the Zamani Foundation.

"Ten more children were supported by the Zamani Foundation to attend school at Kabul Orphan Care. They range in age from 7 to 15. All ten were orphaned at an early age; they are the only members of their family to ever attend school."

They were among the estimated 60,000 street children in Kabul, the Afghan capital, try-ing to earn money to help support their families. They now have food, board, and edu-cation at Kabul Orphan Care; it was established in the west part of Kabul in 2002 and cares around the clock for more than 500 boys and girls.





"The Zamani Foundation's role in helping to provide quality education and stability for younger Afghans is the framework needed for Afghan communities today and the future to help strengthen democracy and boost economic opportunity."

Mustafa Zamani's, the Zamani Foundation's Founder's, main goal is to have no children living on the streets in Kabul. He believes education is the most powerful antidote and the greatest investment we can make in Afghanistan's stability, peace, and development to alleviate poverty.
