

There were nine fallen journalists in Kabul, the worst attack against the media in five years. They left holes in the mission of journalism and in the hearts of their families. Those lost were often the only breadwinners in their families. Three were to be married, another left behind six children, some were close to graduating from universities, all of them had such beautiful futures in store.

As one way to help the families of the reporters, the Zamani Foundation provided food for a year for those who lost a loved one.
