The Zamani Foundation provides school supplies and winter clothing to children in Kunar, including school bags and stationery, as first steps in our larger goal of uplifting the next generation of Afghans. To be successful, students need supplies to use for their educational development, and most orphanages cannot afford to purchase the supplies themselves.

Mohibullah Israr, the program manager in Afghanistan for The Zamani Foundation, coordinated the distribution of 5,400 food packages and hand-woven hats with Abdul Satar Mirakzakwal and Attaullah Noori, who shared detailed information about orphanages in the Kunar Province to help coordinate the deliveries for the following day. The Zamani Foundation visited three orphanages and distributed packages of food and winter clothing to the children at the Asad Abad Orphanage, home to 350 orphans, the Narang District's Sayed Jamaludin orphanage, supported by the World Association of Muslim Youth, housing 400 children, and the Sawkai orphanage, where 50 students are enrolled.
