The Khog Kor orphanage enrolled an additional 13 boys and 17 girls because of the on-going support provided by the Zamani Foundation. The assistance package of 417 backpacks and stationery, two washing machines and one laptop will go toward enhancing a bustling facility that help children pursue their future educational and employment opportunities.

The Zamani Foundation provided the Khog Kor orphanage in Jalalabad, Afghanistan, with the items needed to support current students, including supplies for around 400 children. The 30 students, recently admitted, are going into the first grade and join the existing 400 students in attending classes every day.

Supporting Khog Kor helps the Zamani Foundation illustrate the benefits of working with facilities caring for orphans. It is a first step to expanding to other provinces where we plan to assist orphanages and admit as many orphans as possible in school.

For Khog Kor, the Zamani Foundation also works to improve the internet connection in the orphanage, permitting teachers to use multimedia, especially videos from Youtube and other sites. The orphanage has a very well-equipped computer lab for students with a projector that can be used for the learning process.
