Zamani Foundation sees the way a safe learning environment can inspire young people to ask questions, be creative, and learn from each other. Building a playground at the Shamsa Children's Village is a way to encourage young people, show them they are cared for and that the world is full of opportunity. The Zamani Foundation will continue its holistic support of the youth in Afghanistan, in education, play, health, and in opportunity.



The support to the Shamsa Children's Village ensures that the children become part of a 'family' of nine 'brothers and sisters' of all ages, and an adoptive mother.

They each live in a private home at the village designed to support large families with many children. While Shamsa has a capacity to care for 256 children, they currently care for about 130 children. The Zamani Foundation provides on-going support through its Street Kids Initiative to help the Shamsa Children's Village reach their care capacity.
