The Zamani Foundation has a deep, on-going, multi-faceted support program with Shamsa Children's Village. The facility is qualitatively different and encompasses a new vision and social concept for a responsible and effective protection and upbringing of orphaned or abandoned children. These children are given opportunities to be in a family-centric environment and to learn how to be a resourceful generation for the future of Afghanistan.

Through this support, the Zamani Foundation strengthens the ability of the Shamsa to help provide for children.

The Zamani Foundation took the lead in addressing a major need at Shamsa, internet capability. As part of our effort, we provided document management and Internet training for the management team at Shamsa.

“We also provided clothing, shoes, stationery and school supplies for the new school year to over 120 children.”

Our entire Kabul, Afghanistan office contributed to the effort, handing out the items to the children. Mustafa Zamani has come with the U.S. team on multiple occasions to deliver backpacks and school supplies to Shamsa students.

Shamsa has a capacity to care for 256 children, they currently care for about 130 children. The Zamani Foundation provides on-going support through its Street Kids Initiative. The hope is that this initiative can help the Shamsa Children’s Village reach their care capacity and provide for 256 children.

This orphanage ensures that each child becomes part of a 'family' of nine 'brothers and sisters' of all ages and an adoptive mother. They each live in a private home at the village designed to support large families with many children. Living in this way gives the children a safe place to call home.
